Free COVID-19 Vaccines Available at Monroe County Health Department

Free COVID-19 vaccines are available every Friday in July at Monroe County Health Department, located at 315 W. Oak St. in Sparta. AMI will be offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible age groups during the following dates and times:

- 7/08/2022 from 12pm-7pm
- 7/15/2022 from 12pm-7pm
- 7/22/2022 from 12pm-7pm
- 7/29/2022 from 12pm-7pm

The CDC recommends that everyone age 6 months and older get a COVID-19 vaccine. COVID-19 vaccines are extremely effective at preventing serious illness, hospitalization, and death.

Vaccines available include:

- Pfizer: 6 months – 4 years (3 Dose Series)
- Pfizer: 5 years and up (2 Dose Series and Boosters)
- Moderna: 6 months – 5 years (2 Dose Series)
- Moderna: 18 years and up (2 Dose Series and Boosters)
- Johnson & Johnson: 18 years and up (Single Dose and Booster)
