Free COVID-19 Vaccines Available at Monroe County Health Department

Free COVID-19 vaccines are available every Friday through October 21, 2022 at Monroe County Health Department, located at 315 W. Oak St. in Sparta. AMI will be offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible age groups during the following dates and times:

- 8/12/22: 12pm-7pm
- 8/19/22: 10am – 6pm
- 8/26/22: 10am – 6pm
- 9/2/22: 10am – 6pm
- 9/9/22: 10am – 6pm
- 9/16/22: 10am – 6pm
- 9/23/22: 10am – 6pm
- 9/30/22: 10am – 6pm
- 10/7/22: 10am – 6pm
- 10/14/22: 10am – 6pm
- 10/21/22: 10am – 6pm

Additionally, AMI will be offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible age groups at the Scenic Bluffs Gymnasium, located at 200 W. North St. in Norwalk during the following dates and times:

- 8/24/22: 3pm – 6pm
- 9/28/22: 3pm – 6pm

The CDC recommends that everyone ages 6 months and older get a COVID-19 vaccine. COVID-19 vaccines are extremely effective at preventing serious illness, hospitalization, and death.

Available vaccines include:

- Pfizer: 6 months – 4 years (3 Dose Series)
- Pfizer: 5 years and up (2 Dose Series and Boosters)
- Moderna: 6 months – 5 years (2 Dose Series)
- Moderna: 18 years and up (2 Dose Series and Boosters)
- Johnson & Johnson: 18 years and up (Single Dose and Booster)
